

## Part 7 - Total Redemption

In this final video, Pastor Jamie explores spiritual warfare, focusing on Job's story to illustrate faithfulness in trials and forgiveness. Emphasizing redemption and restoration, the sermon reveals God's ability to bring new abundance from loss. Despite ongoing battles, Jesus secured victory, leading to complete restoration in the new heavens and earth. Believers are encouraged to trust in God's redeeming power for total restoration and to engage in forgiveness and repentance for salvation.

## Part 7 - Total Redemption

Job 42:10-13, 15

10 After Job had prayed for his friends, the Lord made him prosperous again and gave him twice as much as he had before. 11 All his brothers and sisters and everyone who had known him before came and ate with him in his house. They comforted and consoled him over all the trouble the Lord had brought upon him, and each one gave him a piece of silver and a gold ring. 12 The Lord blessed the latter part of Job's life more than the first. He had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, a thousand yoke of oxen and a thousand donkeys. 13 And he also had seven sons and three daughters. 15 Nowhere in all the land were there found women as beautiful as Job's daughters, and their father granted them an inheritance along with their brothers.

Joel 2:25-27

25 "I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten- the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm - my great army that I sent among you. 26 You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the name of the Lord your God, who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed. 27 Then you will know that I am in Israel, that I am the Lord your God, and that there is no other; never again will my people be shamed.

### Discussion Questions:

4. As believers, we trust in God's redeeming power to experience total redemption in body, mind, soul, and relationships. In what areas of your life do you need to trust God more for redemption and restoration? How can you actively practice that trust?
5. Pastor Jamie highlighted how God not only restored what was taken from Job but also brought about something better and more abundant than what was lost. Can you think of a situation where God brought beauty out of the ashes in your life or someone you know? How did this experience impact your faith?

Pray for anyone who is struggling to have hope for their pains to be restored in the future redemption of God.
